Volunteers wishing to start at 8am may wish to help with the cleaning duties.
All new cat socialising volunteers after their induction are requested to start at 8am for their first day to be shown the cleaning duties, procedures and how to socialise the cats safely on site.

Volunteers are welcome at any time during these hours, last cat socialising must be completed before 5.25pm to ensure all cats are settled into their pens.

We ask volunteers to liaise with staff at the Shelter so that a rota can be drawn up.

Task details

Socialising and grooming of the cats in their pens, ideally 15 – 30 mins per cat.
Liaising with staff to ensure correct cats are socialised.
Keeping records updated.
Take part in further training as and when appropriate.

Requirements

Over 16 and covered by tetanus,
Patience and understanding-some of the cats may be nervous, timid, shy, or wary of human contact.
Abide with Shelter rules.
You will be required to bend, sit and play with the cats in their pens.
